Infrastructure & Industrial Development Commissioner (IIDC), Shri Alok Tandon held two meetings here today at Yojna Bhawan for the resolution of industry issues raised at high-level Udyog Bandhu meeting and to review implementation of projects launched during the groundbreaking ceremonies of U.P. Investors' Summit.

High-level Udyog Bandhu Meeting:

IIDC, Shri Alok Tandon chaired a high-level Udyog Bandhu meeting for the resolution of industry issues received from division-level as well as new issues. In all 27 issues were discussed and directions were issued for their speedy resolution.

Addressing the entrepreneurs, IIDC said that all departments concerned should resolve issues of industry according to the policies and rules within a fixed time frame, so that the entrepreneurs need to come to Udyog Bandhu meeting only once.

In order to resolve the issue of drainage of industrial water in Rania area of Kanpur, **Shri Tandon directed** that appropriate action should be taken at Divisional Commissioner level for setting up of a common effluent treatment plant.

He further instructed the U.P. Power Corporation to set up a power substation for uninterrupted power supply at the upcoming mega food park at Baheri, Bareilly within six months. Similarly, directions were issued to complete measurement and layout plan within 15 days for the establishment of industrial park in 1196 acres at Bhara Pachpera, Pilibhit.

Principal Secretary, Infrastructure & Industrial Development, Shri Alok Kumar assured that unambiguous rules would soon be formulated for percentage of exemption from Mandi fee to the new food processing units, in which capital investment in plant and machinery is Rs. 5 crores or more.

In today's meeting, issues related to Infrastructure and Industrial Development Department, Revenue Department, Housing Department, Urban Development Department, Agricultural Marketing Department, Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Department, Panchayati Raj Department, U.P. State Industrial Development Authority (UPSIDA) and PICUP were considered for resolution.

Apart from entrepreneurs, Principal Secretary, Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises - Mr. Navneet Sehgal, Chief Executive Officer, UPCIDA - Mr. Anil Garg and Secretary, Infrastructure and Industrial Development and Executive Director, Udyog Bandhu - Mrs. Neena Sharma along with senior of 10 related departments Officers attended the meeting.
