Varanasi: In a remarkable feat, Prime Minister Narendra Modi's parliamentary constituency Varanasi has bagged the first position among the 100 smart cities of the country in project implementation on the basis of completed and progressive ongoing projects.

Bhopal is ranked second, followed by Surat on third and Ahmedabad on the fourth rung in the list. Two more cities from Uttar Pradesh are in the top 10 of the list, with Agra on seventh and Kanpur on eighth.

ited spokesperson Shakambhari Nandan Sonthalia told TOI, "The Union ministry of housing and urban affairs released the first quarter ranking of smart cities on Friday Asperthe Geographical Management Information System (GMIS) data, other cities in the top10 are Indore (fifth), Salem (sixth), Agra (seventh), Kanpur (eighth), Dehradun (ninth) and Davangere (10th)."

Varanasi was on 13th position in January 2020, and had jumped to the seventh position in August 2020 ranking list, he adde. The development projects in Varanasi under the Smart City scheme have been going on at a fast pace and dedication.

At present, a total of 29 projects worth Rs 586 crore, including Godowlia multilevel parking, development of six model wards, redevelopment of Khidkiya Ghat, advance surveillance camera system for security, park and parking in Beniabagh are in progress, while 16 projects worth Rs 261 crore have been completed and tenders issued for three projects worth Rs 157 crore.
