Stalls of GI tagged products from Varanasi, Bhadohi, Chandauli, Ghazipur, Mirzapur, Azamgarh, Bulandshahr, Farrukhabad, Firozabad, Gorakhpur, Kanpur, Kannauj, Lucknow, Prayagraj, Saharanpur and Siddharthanagar will be set up. As many as 28 unique GI products, including seven from Varanasi, will be displayed. The exhibition will provide a platform for communication between sellers and buyers.

Some products which have been given GI tag in UP are terracotta of Gorakhpur, brocade and silk of Varanasi, black pottery of Azamgarh, handmade carpets of Bhadohi, perfume of Kannauj, metal craft of Moradabad, pottery of Khurja and Kala Namak rice of Siddharthnagar. The government will train 240 craftspersons under the technical upgradation training program.
