Lucknow: To attract foreign investors, the UP government has launched a micro website for Uttar Pradesh defence industrial corridor.

The site <http://upeida.in/updic/index.html> will give investors an access to latest policies and updates on the corridor such as incentives, availability of plots, information regarding existing infrastructure, network at nodes and guidelines of the state government's ambitious project.
