Lucknow: A delegation from Taiwan on Friday met minister for environment, forests and climate change Dara Singh Chauhan and expressed gratitude for having invited them to the UP Climate Change Conclave-2021 in Lucknow.

Taiwan's ambassador to India Baushuan Ger, along with a five-member delegation of Taipei Economic and Cultural Centre in India (TECC), met the minister and additional chief secretary of the department Manoj Singh.

Baushuan said he wished to work jointly with India and Uttar Pradesh on science and technology with respect to converting waste to greenery. He stressed the need for Indians to learn Mandarin to pave the way to bolster bilateral cultural ties between the two countries.
