The conclave will see a wide ranging panel of experts, bureaucrats and ministers discuss the potential of UP across various sectors like tourism, industry, IT etc. Spread across five sessions, the day will start with Union minister Dharmendra Pradhan talk about the importance of the work force in UP. The second session will set the context being set for the event with aviation minister Nand Gopal

Nandi, industrial development minister Satish Mahana, power minister Shrikant Sharma and tourism minister Neelkanth Tiwari talk about the progress in their respective departments and future plans.

The third session will focus on the creation of an enabling environment in the state, through infrastructural development and policy interventions. Additional chief secretary, home, Awanish Awasthi will focus on infrastructure through a vast network of expressways while additional chief secretary, industries, Arvind Kumar will speak about the sectoral policies implemented in the state to attract investments through a variety of incentives and concessions. Arvind Jain, former DGP, has been invited to discuss the law and order situation in the state and its impact on various aspects of

development. The two concluding technical sessions will look at UP's potential through a sectoral approach. Major areas which will be covered during these sessions include tourism, hospitality, UP government's flagship one district-one product scheme, the upcoming defence corridor which is one of the two which are being developed in the country, film production in light of the proposed Film City in Noida, renewable energy start-ups, development of data hub and information technology. Prominent speakers at these sessions will include MSME minister Sidharth Nath Singh; additional chief secretary, MSME, Navneet Sehgal; principal secretary, tourism, Mukesh Meshram; director general of Society of Indian Defence Manufacturers, Sunil Kumar Mishra, and Gorakhpur MP and actor Ravi Kishan.
