MSMEs must adopt latest tech: Sehgal

Lucknow: Addressing the second edition of the MSME Conclave on Thursday, additional chief secretary (MSME) Navneet Sehgal said that more and more MSMEs should be encouraged to register with the government so that they can take advantage of government schemes.

Talking about the use of technology at the event where the focus was on how to encourage MSMEs to adopt technology and to create awareness about financing options, the additional chief secretary said that pilot projects are being run in the Moradabad and Varanasi districts to enable business units to use computer aided designing facilities and other common cloud services.
