

Noida International Airport: Construction Of Terminal And Runway To Begin Next Month, L&T And Tata Among Bidders

Snapshot

- *Spread over an area of 5,000 hectares, Noida international airport is estimated to become India's largest airport upon completing all the project phases.*
- *L&T Construction, Tata Projects and Shapoorji Pallonji, have participated in the bidding process for phase-1 of the project, which will spread over 1,327 hectares.*

The construction work on phase-1 of the first terminal building, first runway, air traffic control (ATC) tower and other facilities of the Noida international airport at Jewar in Uttar Pradesh will begin next month.

Initially, the airport will start operations only with one runway and with a capacity of handling 12 million passengers per annum. The first runway will be 3,900m-long and 45m-wide.
