CM Yogi Adityanath invites Mauritius businessmen for UP Summit

LUCKNOW: Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath has invited Mauritian investors to invest in the state as well as participate in the Global Investors Summit proposed to be held in the state soon.

During a recent meeting with Mauritius PM Pravind Kumar Jugnauth in Varanasi, Yogi also promised Jagannath cooperation in helping natives of Mauritius with Indian origins connect to their roots.

The CM informed the Mauritian PM that Asia's largest airport is being built in Jewar in Uttar Pradesh. The share of Uttar Pradesh in mobile manufacturing is 60% in the country. In the last five years, UP has seen huge investment in the field of IT and electronics.

The Mauritian PM, expressing his happiness on his visit to Kashi, said, "Mauritius has an emotional attachment to India. Both the countries can expand the prospects of development to a great extent.
