Uttar Pradesh's capital, Lucknow, is all set and decked up to welcome Prime Minister Narendra Modi, union ministers and business tycoons, with tricolour lights all around in the run-up to the third ground-breaking ceremony at the Indira Gandhi Prasthithan.

The event will mark the implementation of MoUs for investment proposals worth more than Rs 80,000 crore in the state.

The Ground Breaking Ceremony 3 (GBC III), scheduled to take place on June 3, will see a maximum of 805 projects in the MSME sector coming on the ground, followed by 275 projects of agriculture and allied industries and 65 projects of pharmaceuticals and medical supplies.

On the initiative of UP Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath, investment proposals worth Rs 4,68,800 were received in the Investors Summit in 2018, after which the third GBC is going to take place in the state.

The other projects coming on the ground include six projects related to education worth Rs 1,183 crore, seven projects worth Rs 489 crore of dairy and six of animal husbandry worth Rs 224 crore.

The state has 90 lakh MSMEs, which is a 14.2 per cent share of the total MSMEs in the country.

In GBC III, projects worth Rs 4,459 crore are being set up in the state. These include two in Agra, three in Aligarh, two in Amethi, one in Ayodhya, seven in Barabanki, two in Bareilly, one each in Chandauli, Etawah and Firozabad, six in Gorakhpur, four in Hardoi, one in Hathras, one in Jaunpur, four in Kanpur Dehat, four in Kanpur Nagar, one in Lakhimpur Kheri, eight in Lucknow, 15 in Mathura, one in Meerut, one in Moradabad, one in Saharanpur, one in Shahjahanpur, one in Sitapur and two in Varanasi.

Furthermore, projects will also be proposed for Fatehpur, Gautam Budh Nagar and Ghaziabad areas.

PROJECTS TO BE PROPOSED

Investment proposals worth Rs 80,000 crore are coming on the ground in GBC III.

In addition to MSMEs, during the ceremony, 29 projects, all above Rs 500 crore each, accounting for Rs 40,106 crore of the total investment of Rs 80,224 crore, are scheduled to come on the ground.

Similarly, there are 52 projects worth Rs 15,614 crore, amounting between Rs 200 and Rs 500 crore. There are also 112 projects worth Rs 9,959 crore, ranging from Rs 50 crore to Rs 200 crore.

The projects coming up include seven data centers, agriculture and allied industries, 26 IT and electronics projects, 13 infrastructure projects and 27 manufacturing projects.

Projects in the fields of renewable energy, handlooms and textiles, housing and commercial, MSMEs, health care, defence, warehousing and logistics, education, animal husbandry, and tourism, among others, will be proposed.

A film project is also going to hit the ground estimated at a cost of Rs 100 crore.
