

Uttar Pradesh: 296 Km Long Bundelkhand Expressway Likely To Be Inaugurated In First Week Of July

Bundelkhand Expressway in Uttar Pradesh is likely to be inaugurated in the first week of July as over 95 per cent work has been completed on the project.

The project is being executed by the Uttar Pradesh Expressways Industrial Development Authority (UPEIDA).

"The inauguration of Bundelkhand Expressway is likely to be in the first week of July," Durgesh Upadhya, media advisor to UPEIDA, tweeted on Saturdayn (4 June).

"The Construction work is in the final stages..more than 95 per cent of work has been completed," he added.

The 296-kilometre-long expressway was proposed by Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath in April 2017, just months after he took office for the first time. Prime Minister Narendra Modi laid the foundation stone for constructing the expressway on 29 February 2020.

2021, the Uttar Pradesh government has achieved over 94 per cent completion within 27 months since laying the foundation.

developers like Apco Infratech, Ashoka Buildcon, Gavar Construction and Dilip Bildcon. With the construction of the expressway, the Bundelkhand area will be linked with a fast and smooth traffic corridor to the Agra-Lucknow expressway and

Yamuna expressway, thus further connected to the National Capital Region
