UP to hold roadshows abroad to meet GIS goal

Lucknow: With a Global Investors' Summit (GIS) planned for January 2023, Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath has directed all ministers to visit other countries and invite investors to participate in the event. The government has planned roadshows in about a dozen countries. The CM himself may visit one of these countries later to drive the efforts to meet the target Rs 10 lakh-crore investment.

The idea was floated during a meeting with ministers on Tuesday and by Wednesday, preparations were on to form groups of ministers and identify countries where they will be holding road shows. Singapore has already expressed its interest in becoming the first country partner with UP for this event. Earlier, in the 2018 investors' summit, UP had partne-

red with Netherlands, Japan, Slovakia, Finland, Czech Republic, Mauritius, Thailand, Nepal and Belgium. In addition to this, there are plans to hold road shows in the USA, Canada, UAE, Sweden, Singapore, Netherlands, Israel, France, Germany, South Korea, Mauritius, Russia and Australia.
