

Officials from UP brush up on key concepts of PM Gati Shakti plan

Lucknow: Nodal and technical officers from at least 25 departments got a chance to decode key concepts related to the PM Gati Shakti national master plan at a capacity building workshop held here on Friday.

Addressing the delegates at the programme, chief executive officer, Invest UP and head of technical support unit on PM Gati Shakti, Abhishek Prakash said: "PM Gati Shakti national master plan is aimed at creating a system for inter-connected and multimodal transportation networks to integrate economic and infrastructure development, improved trade

competitiveness, promotion of exports and employment generation."

Explaining about the portal, he said: "Three types of data formats — point, line and polygon — may be used

by the departments to upload their information. Electric poles would be put up as point data, transmission lines and roads would be shown as line data and information related to ponds, dams and so

on would be uploaded as polygon data."

Project manager, Remote Sensing Application Centre, UP (where the workshop was held), Susheel Chandra apprised the delegates of the functioning of the PM Gati Shakti portal along with key processes such as verification, updation and integration of different layers.

Officials said that the PM Gati Shakti national master plan aims to develop a multimodal digital connectivity platform to integrate planning of infrastructure projects and achieve seamless coordination between various ministries and departments for better utilization of resources.
