Jewar airport to be made eco-friendly green facility

Lucknow: The upcoming Jewar airport in Noida will be developed as an eco-friendly green airport.

Chairing a review meeting on Wednesday, chief secretary DS Mishra said that emphasis should be placed on saving every drop of water. "The water balance and water management plan of the airport should be made with exhaustive research so that there is no problem of water in future," he said. Mishra said airport should have a complete system of water recycling with STP, ra-

in water harvesting and water storage.

Mishra said that "by using modern technology, we have to work on strengthening airport security and on a system which is paperless. The work has to be progressed rapidly with the mutual coordination of departments. With the new technology let us develop Jewar Airport as a model airport that will become an inspiration to the world."

The chief secretary said the UP government has approved the policy of maintenance, repairing and overhauling (MRO) of aircraft. Under this two big MRO hubs will be built near the Noida International Airport. After the construction of MROs the aircraft will not have to go abroad for repair.

Mishra said Jewar Airport would develop into a major commercial hub of the country besides meeting the growing aviation needs of the country including NCR and the state. Special emphasis should be given to promote air cargo with a view to increase the export of industrial units, handicrafts and farmers' products along with increasing the convenience of tourists, he said.
