

Investors for 15 tourism sites finalised

Lucknow: The state government has finalised investors for development of 15 Uttar Pradesh state tourism development corporation (UPSTDC) properties.

The investors will be working on a public private partnership mode for revamping the hotels or bungalows of the UPSTDC.

A request for proposal for development of 30 properties was floated by the state government in April and on Friday, tender for 15 properties was opened.

The date for remaining 15 properties has been extended as the number of applicants was not found to be up to the mark.

Officials at the state tourism department said the investors for Mathura's Gokul Restaurant, Tourist rest house, Radha Kund, Barasana and Gokul village have been fixed.

The other units where development would take place are Sonauli in Maharajganj, Devkali in Auraiya, Deogarh in Lalitpur, Shikohabad in Firozabad, Bateshwar in Agra, Sankisa in Farukhabad, Narora in Bulandshahr and Bhadohi.
