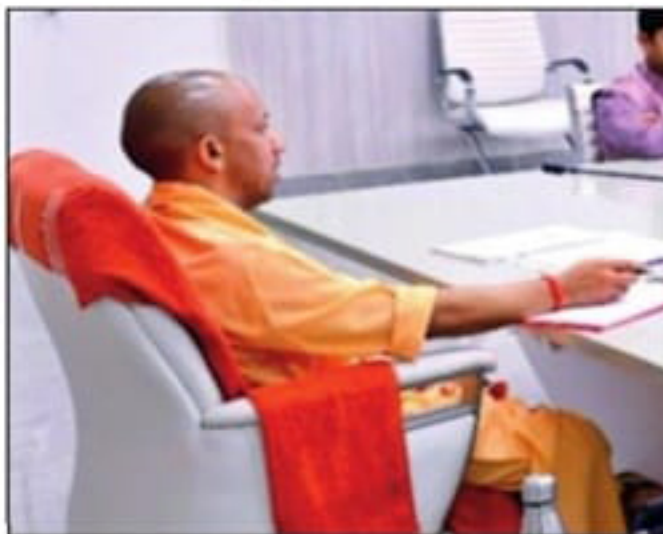


Global Investor Summit to be held in city from Feb 10-12

Lucknow: The promotional campaign of the Global Investor Summit 2023, scheduled to take place between February 10-12 in the state capital, will pass through 21 cities across 19 countries via nine routes, officials said.

At a review of preparations for the GIS-2023 undertaken by chief minister Yogi Adityanath in the presence of departmental minister Nand Gopal Gupta Nandi on Thursday, senior officials from the industries and infrastructure development department along with authorities from other stakeholder departments apprised the CM of the progress of work on various counts. As per the official document, the first route will woo entrepreneurs in the US, Canada and Brazil in the cities of New York, San Francisco, Toronto and Rio de Janeiro, while the second would tap potential investors from UK, Netherlands and France in the cities of London, Eindhoven and Paris.
