

State's first skill devpt univ may be set up in Kashi

Lucknow: Uttar Pradesh government is set to build its first skill development university in Varanasi.

“Different stakeholders are being contacted for the acquisition of land in Varanasi. The feasibility study is also on, and the land selection process is likely to complete in the next six months,” said an official.

Uttar Pradesh is the first state in the country to set up the Skill Development Mission. In the past five years, the state government has trained around 10 lakh youths through various skill development centres and over five lakh youths have been linked with employment programmes.
