Lucknow: A day after Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath directed officials to prepare a plan for developing Lucknow and seven adjoining districts as a UP State Capital Region (SCR), on the lines of Delhi NCR, the government on Saturday said that work had already started on the proposal and a draft plan would be presented before the CM in a we-

The seven districts the proposed region will cover are - Lucknow, Sitapur, Unnao, Rae Bareli, Kanpur Dehat, Kanpur Nagar and Barabanki.



the SCR. However, a final decision will be taken after the preparation of the detailed action plan. In future, the SCR may be expanded to include more districts," he sa-

On Friday, Yogi had said that Lucknow had developed with enviable infrastructure

because of which people were being drawn to it from near and far in search of work and to live in. The city had seen massive development and an influx of investment, making it an attractive destination for those seeking better opportunities.

The area around the state

capital had been expanding at a massive speed but a lot of this was unplanned.

"The CM has said that in order to have sustainable growth, an international standard of healthcare, education and infrastructure, and preservation of culture, a concept like the SCR is nee-

ded. This, he has said, will ensure balanced, inclusive and sustainable urban development in and around Lucknow," the spokesperson said.

Taking cue from Delhi National Capital Region (NCR), of which some cities from UP like Noida and Ghaziabad are a part, the SCR scheme will work towards finding solutions to challenges like pressure on infrastructure due to increasing population, and unplanned and lopsided development of areas in and around Lucknow.

The CM has asked for a plan on developing hi-tech townships in Sitapur, Unnao, Rae Bareli, Kanpur Nagar, Kanpur Dehat and Barabanki which will be equipped with Metro services and planned industrial development to ease the pressure on Luck-

Two committees are being set up to work on this proposal. A high powered committee headed by the chief secretary will have additional chief secretaries and principal secretaries of all departments concerned as members.

The other will be an executive committee, which will be constituted under the chairmanship of the additional chief secretary or principal secretary of the housing and urban planning department.

Its members will include the divisional commissioners of Lucknow, Kanpur and Ayodhya divisions, district magistrates of the seven districts scheduled to be part of the SCR, vice-chairpersons of the respective development authorities and planning experts.
