

U.P. govt identifies 21 cities in 19 countries for road shows

LUCKNOW: The Uttar Pradesh government has identified 21 cities in 19 countries for international roads shows to woo investors for the Uttar Pradesh Global Investors Summit-2023 (UPGIS-2023). The summit is scheduled on February 10-12, 2023 to attract Rs 10 lakh crore investment.

Chief minister Yogi Adityanath, deputy chief ministers Keshav Prasad Maurya and Brajesh Pathak and some ministers

will participate in the roads shows. Though most senior officers remained tight-lipped about the destinations to be covered by

Yogi and his teams, those aware of the developments said road shows have been proposed on different days in November 2022.

Yogi's visit has been proposed to New York (USA), Bangkok (Thailand), Moscow (Russia) and Port Louis (Mauritius). One of the two deputy chief ministers is likely to lead separate teams to San Francisco (USA), Toronto (Canada) and Rio de Janeiro (Brazil) while the other one may lead a team to Paris (France), London (UK) and Eindhoven (Netherlands).
