

# CM lists achievements, says UP first in implementing schemes

**Lucknow:** Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath listed out the achievements of his government in response to the opposition furore in the assembly and said that Uttar Pradesh is number one in implementing schemes in the country.

CM Yogi said that Uttar Pradesh is number one in sugarcane production and in giving connections under Ujjwala Yojana in the country. He informed the House that under Ujjwala, free cooking gas connections have been provided to 1.74 crore families in the state so far.

Yogi added further that Uttar Pradesh is also number one in construction of expressways and in giving maintenance allowance to the labourers and street vendors of the state.

Further, the CM remarked that the state also tops in making payments through DBT in grants payable to farmers on agricultural inputs.

He said UP is also number one in food grain production in the country and in providing toilets to the poor. Uttar Pradesh is the first state in the country to declare human-wildlife conflict as a dis-

## ‘Women’s helpdesks set up in all thanas’

**Lucknow:** Addressing the issue of women’s empowerment, CM on Saturday said women’s helpdesks have been set up in all 1537 police stations and 1584 GRP stations of the state. “Also, in each district an additional women’s police station as well as an additional woman counselling post has been established. Besides, 10417 women beat have been formed in all police stations and ‘Mission Shakti Kaksha’ has been constructed in all gram panchayats where village secretariat has been set up,” said the CM in the House while replying to opposition query of women empowerment. He said in 2017, the number of women personnel in Uttar Pradesh Police was only 13,000 which today stands at over 32,000. Because of successful prosecution of women’s and children’s rights violations, 35 criminals have received death penalty, more than 1200 have received sentences of over 10 years,, he added. TNN
