UP's religious sites get ₹4L cr investment proposals at GIS

Lucknow: Uttar Pradesh's religious and spiritual centres, which have been witnessing major development under the BJP government, have received investment proposals of Rs 4.14 lakh crore during the Global Investors Summit.

These investment propo-

sals, said a government spokesperson, have been received under various sectors such as tourism, hotels, logistics, education and will generate 4.35 lakh employment opportunities in the state. Varanasi, the Lok Sabha constituency of PM Narendra Modi, has received the maximum interest among religious cities for which 434

proposals worth Rs 1.37 lakh crore have been made. Employment for 1.35 lakh people will be opened up through this. The city has seen a sharp increase in tourists, the official said, after the Kashi Vishwanath corridor was inaugurated.

Ayodhya, where the Ram temple is being constructed, received investment proposals of

Rs 45,402 crore. This will generate employment for 53,472 people. Next in line is the Vindhyanchal Dham of Maa Vindhvavasini in Mirzapur, for which investment proposals of Rs 64.010 crore have been received. which promise employment for 25,000 people.
