UP to table ₹7L-cr budget, House session begins today

Lucknow: UP finance minister Suresh Khanna is likely to table Rs 7 lakh crore budget on February 22 as the assembly session takes off on Monday. This would be Rs 50,000 crore increase over the previous year's budget.

After coming back to power in March last year, the Yogi 2.0 government tabled Rs 6.15 lakh crore budget in May. Later, Rs 33,000 crore were added through supplementary demands.

Since it is the first session of the assembly this year, the

proceedings will start with Governor Anandiben Patel addressing the joint session of the house on the first day.
