Lucknow: The Uttar Pradesh government has begun the spadework on an ambitious project related to setting up a new industrial township on the lines of Noida and Greater Noida.

The town is likely to come up somewhere near Jhansi and Lalitpur area.

While the idea is in its nascent stage, sources said the requisite initial budget required for the initiation of the ambitious project is likely to be drawn from the provisions for industrial development in the state budget 2023-2024.

ed be, funds could also be taken from Rs 8,000 crore earmarked for industrial development in the supplementary budget passed in December 2022.

The government is of the view that since the focus of industrialisation has primarily been in Noida

and Greater Noida, the other parts of Uttar Pradesh have been devoid of growth, a fact which affects the economy of the state in other parts.

And hence the government feels that another industrial township should come up in Bundelkhand region.

The region continues to lag as compared to other parts of the state.

Since the Yogi Adityanath government has started focussing on the infrastructure development of the region, industrial township idea can very much be implemented here, feel many.
