

Yogi to gift ₹2K cr projects to Kushinagar

Gorakhpur: Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath will inaugurate 329 development projects worth Rs 422 crore during a function in Khadda tehsil of Kushinagar district on Wednesday. On the occasion, he will also lay the foundation for 461 projects of Rs 1546 crore.

Sources close to the development said Yogi has been taking issues of Kushinagar under serious consideration ever since he became an MP from Gorakhpur, though the area was not under his parliamentary constituency. He raised voice for the poor condition of people belonging to Mushar community and against encephalitis in the area. After becoming chief minister, he took several concrete measures that controlled the disease and brought positive changes in the lives of Mushar community people.

On Wednesday, the CM will inaugurate a free dialysis centre at Bharouli in Gola tehsil of Gorakhpur and unveil statue of Swargiya Singh on the Ramsakhi Ramniwas Shikshan Sankul campus.
