Over 1K GIS projects allotted land in state

Efforts On To Provide Land For 400 MoUs

Lucknow: The UP government has ensured the availability of land for over 1,000 projects for which it received requests from investors during the Global Investor Summit(GIS) held in February, a state government spokesperson said on Sunday.

He said that the state government was making constant efforts to provide land to investors. Of more than 22,000 investments which came during the GIS, the government received land acquisition requests for more than 1,450 projects. "Efforts are being made to make land available for the remaining over 400 MoUs," the spokesperson said, adding that the state government instructed all the departments to ensure availability of land on the basis of MoU. Many depart-

ments including UPSIDA have already started work on land bank-like facilities, he said.

The spokesperson said that the state government completed the process of allotment of land to implement two MoUs on the ground before the GIS. "The government has suggested land options to 16 investors as per their demand," he said.

According to the UP government, highest demand has been received for Gautam Budh Nagar and Ghaziabad in the National Capital Region. Lucknow has been

reported with the availability of maximum land, the spokesperson said.

Land was demanded for 72 MoUs in Lucknow, against which a maximum of 46 land areas have been made available. Similarly, land was made available for 42 out of 51 projects in Aligarh, 42 out of 43 projects in Azamgarh, 40 out of 44 projects in Jaunpur, 36 out of 93 in Gautam Budh Nagar and 32 out of 44 in Meerut. Ghaziabad has the highest demand for 157 projects and 18 have already alltted land, the spokesperson said.

Apart from Lucknow, there are districts where 100% land availability has been ensured as per the demand. They include Fatehpur (19), Mau (10), Chandauli (12), Hamirpur (11), Mahoba (11), Ambedkarnagar (10), Farrukhabad (5), Shravasti (4), Siddharthnagar (4), Ballia (3), Kaushambi (2), Lakhimpur Kheri (2) and Pilibhit (1).

The DMs of all the districts have been asked to provide information about the availability of land to the investors through Invest UP.
