

RRTS services will be available every 15 minutes

The train service will operate from 6am to 11pm. There will be 24 stations in the entire corridor, out of which 13 stations will be in Meerut for the local transit services. According to NCRTC official source, the train services will be available every 15 minutes initially and will be increased as per ridership demand.

Glass lifts have been installed inside the stations to make the station appear more airy, spacious, open, and lit. Platform Screen Doors have been installed at every station for passengers safety. Drinking water and wash-room facilities have been provided in the paid area of the concourse level at every station.

Special arrangements have been made at RAPIDX stations for hassle-free movement of visually challenged persons. Dedicated tactile paths have been created to avoid any confusion and show them the shortest possible route to key areas in the station.

The entire corridor of 82 km is expected to be completed by 2025 with total expenditure Rs 30,274 crore. Around 8 lakh commuters will travel daily with RAPIDX.

In Uttar Pradesh, RAPIDX will cover 68km with a 7km underground section, while Delhi will have a 14km long section with 5km underground track.
