

CM: Finish PM Gati Shakti works on time

Lucknow: Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath reviewed the progress on PM Gati Shakti projects and gave directions to officials to ensure no project linked with the Centre remained pending. If any such project was found delayed, the officers in charge would be held responsible, he warned.

“These projects will be reviewed regularly at the CM Office level. Departments associated with land acquisition matters should deploy additional manpower and dispose of these issues quickly. There should be no delay in issuing compensation in such matters. For issues pending in courts, make efforts to have these matters disposed of at the earliest,” the CM said.

Out of the 351 matters registered on PMG Portal, 321 had been disposed of. The remaining 30 projects come under departments of industrial development, revenue, PWD, irrigation, environment, forest and climate change, health and family welfare, power and civil aviation.
