

E-auction for 154 plots by UPSIDA

Kanpur/Lucknow: The Uttar Pradesh Industrial Development Authority launched an e-auction scheme for 154 plots across 18 districts.

“The highlight of the scheme is that UPSIDA has mapped the MoUs signed during the UP Investor Summit with the specific plot requirement/demand of the investors. This will ensure timely allotment of the land to the bidders,” an official spokesperson said, citing CEO Mayur Maheshwari. He added, “The running auction will materialize MoUs of investment worth Rs 3,000 crores.”

Sharing details, UPSIDA officials said that a total of more than 100 acres of land will be allotted through auction through this scheme. The plots will be available in Mathura, Greater Noida, Kanpur Dehat,

Fatehpur, Jalaun, Jhansi, Barabanki, Hardoi, Amethi, Varanasi, Shahjahanpur, Ghaziabad, Deoria, Baghpat, Hamirpur, Amroha, Etah, Mainpuri. Likewise, industrial plots ranging from 200 square metres to 90000 square metres have been launched. Apart from industrial plots, warehousing, data centres, hotels, schools, hospital plots will also be available to investors soon.

Officials claimed that more details about the scheme may be gathered from UPSIDA website while the brochures may be collected from State Bank of India from July 6. “Investors can register by visiting the portal from Tuesday and make online payment till July 6 and the application can be made online till July 8, 2023, till 06 pm. The auction of these plots will be done on July 13, 2023,” the spokesperson said.
