

UPPCL to get Etah plant on by July 15

Lucknow: UP Power Corporation Limited (UPPCL) chairman M Devaraja on Thursday asked officials to speed up work at the upcoming 660 mw unit in Jawaharpur power plant in Etah.

While the unit was proposed to be synchronised in April this year, the tardy pace of construction has delayed the project. The other 660 mw unit too was scheduled to be fired up in six months, which also has been delayed.

On Thursday, Devaraja, who also holds the charge of UP Rajya Vidyut Utpadan Nigam Limited (UPRVUNL), reached the power plant site and held a detailed review meeting with the power officials and district administration.

The UPPCL has been seeking timely operation of the unit for wheeling in additional power into the UP power grid to meet the ever rising demand.
