Modi inaugurates UP's first land port in presence of Nepalese PM

Bahraich: PM Narendra Modi on Thursday virtually inaugurated Uttar Pradesh's first land port, also called an integrated check post, at Rupaidiha in Bahraich district in the presence of Nepal PM Pushpa Kamal Dahal Prachanda. Soon after the inauguration, a truck from the Nepal side was sent to the Indian Land Port Authority of India, while a truck from the Indian side was sent to Nepal International Transport Land Port of Nepal.

The check post, established with a cost of Rs 200 crore, will further strengthen the business relationship between India and Nepal as the volume of trade is expected to go up significantly with the number of trucks passing through this border daily set to increase from 200 to at least 300. TNN
