LDA begins work on 56 GIS projects

Lucknow: Lucknow Development Authority has started work on 56 projects out of the 116 MoUs that were signed during the Global Investor's Summit. This was revealed in a meeting between investors and LDA officials on Saturday.

During GIS, 116 MoUs) worth Rs 31,000 crore were signed. The projects that have got underway have created about 3,500 direct jobs and 6,000 indirect jobs, according to LDA officials.

Additional secretary, LDA, Gyanendra Verma said 78 projects worth Rs 16,500 crore are ready for groundbreaking ceremonies.

LDA vice-chairman Indramani Tripathi said the remaining projects will be launched promptly. He also instructed the zo-

nal officers to carry out a special campaign to demolish illegal structures and develop a detailed action plan.

Meanwhile, investors'

representatives raised concerns about illegal constructions and plotting in their projects. Tripathi instructed the officers to resolve any bottlenecks regarding No Objection Certificates (NOC) by arranging early meetings with the relevant

departments.
