Lucknow: Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath on Monday launched the Micro Entrepreneur Accident Insurance Scheme under which financial support of Rs 5 lakh will be given to small entrepreneurs in the case of death or accident.

tive. Yogi said the opportunity for entrepreneurs to register with the government would be open for one year.

The state has around 96 lakh MSME entrepreneurs, of which 97% are operating as micro-enterprises with a venture capital under Rs 5 crore and an annual turnover of below Rs 40 lakh.
