
UP is scaling new heights of devpt due to rule of law: PM

Lucknow/New Delhi: Stressing that law and order is key to attract investment, Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Monday cited Uttar Pradesh as a case in point and said good governance in the state in recent years had led to 'Rule of Law', which had brought in a lot of investments.

"An atmosphere of security, rule of law speeds up the pace of development. You can take the example of Uttar Pradesh ... There was a time when the state was lagging behind in terms of development and was notorious for high rates of crime ... Now a society free from fear has been established in Uttar Pradesh. And when crime has reduced, investments are increasing in the
