Ganga e-way: ₹10cr for land in Sambhal

Lucknow: To ensure speedy construction of Ganga Expressway, the Yogi Adityanath government on Thursday sanctioned Rs 10 crore for purchase of land in Sambhal.

The project that will connect Meerut to Prayagraj is being developed under PPP mode and the state government has to provide the land to private construction companies.

UP Expressways Industrial Development Authority has been asked to complete the project by December 2024 to provide easy connectivity to Prayagraj before Maha Kumbh 2025.

At present, the project has progressed up to 21%. While land related work has been achieved up to 41%, clearing and grubbing of the main carriageway is also underway.

Also, 514 structures of total 1,348 stand complete while dense bituminous macadam has been laid down over 12% of the main carriageway.

"The monsoon has impacted the progress, but our men are focusing on works that could be carried out during the rainy season," said a senior officer. Ganga e-way
