

MotoGP done, F1 to return to UP in 2025?

Noida: Could Formula One return to India? The success of MotoGP Bharat has put wind in the sails of efforts that have quietly begun to bring back the supercars, reports Aditya Dev. Senior officials at the Yamuna Expressway Industrial Development Authority revealed talks were on to reintroduce the F1 at the Buddh International Circuit (BIC) in 2025, reports Aditya Dev.

Formula One, which has legions of fans in India, held its first Indian Grand Prix at the BIC in 2011, but made an abrupt exit after the 2013 race once the Uttar Pradesh government decided to withdraw the exemption it had given the organiser on entertainment tax.

The decision imposed a long spell of hibernation on the BIC.
