The planning of this park has been done with a belief that it will become the main sports arena should India get a chance to host the Olympics or any other international sports event beyond 2041," said Arun Vir Singh, CEO of the Yamuna Expressway Industrial Development Authority. "What will set it apart from the world-class stadiums in Delhi is the sports cluster with 29 stadiums,"

he added.

While the park is likely to be developed over several years, a "sequential and logical phasing" of development and infrastructure

will be necessary to minimise uncertainty and improve the economic feasibility of the project, the CEO said. Though YEIDA is yet to finalise the mode of construction, officials said the public-private partnership (PPP) model is best suited for developing any international sports facility. The UP government has planned several big projects with the airport in Jewar at the centre in the Yamuna Expressway region, among them the Film City and industrial manufacturing clusters like the toy, apparel and medical devices parks.
