

YEIDA begins process to allot plots for data centres

Lucknow: Levelling up efforts for developing UP as a hub of data centres, the Yamuna Expressway Industrial Development Authority (YEIDA) started the process to allot land for the centres in Sector 28 of Greater Noida.

An official spokesperson said that applications for the plots may be filed through the Nivesh Mitra portal. They said details about the plot area, sector, rate of allotment per square meter, preferential location charge (PLC), registration amount and total premium have been provided.

Moreover, the rate allot-

ment per square metre for plotting number D-1 of Rs 1.25 lakh square meter in Sector 28 of Greater Noida has been fixed at Rs 12,786. On this, the registration amount, according to 10% PLC, has been fixed at Rs 17.67 crore. The total premium has been fixed at Rs 176.73 crore (including PLC), which is the highest.
