

Review GIS intents for groundbreaking event: CS

Lucknow: Chief secretary DS Mishra has communicated to all district magistrates and divisional commissioners that it is proposed to have the groundbreaking ceremony for investment intents made during the UP Global Investors Summit, after Diwali. With very little time left for the ceremony, work needs to be completed on priority, Mishra said during a review meeting. In a review of the Jal Jeevan mission, Mishra appreciated the 100% coverage through functional household tap connections in the Bisanda block in Banda district and Charkhari block in Mahoba district. He said that in the 10 best performing districts and 50 best blocks, officials should aim to provide 100% coverage by December 31.

The CM said that UP is among the top performing states in the country under the Jal Jeevan mission. The depart-

ment of panchayati raj will finalise a list of Nal Jal mitras by October 25 and hand it over to the department of technical education and skill development. Women should be given priority in selection of Nal Jal mitras. As per the Jal Jeevan Sarvekshan released on October 16, Mathura has been named in the best performing district under the aspirant district category. Under fastest moving districts, Jaunpur is second in the performers category, followed by Aligarh in the third position.

The CS said that the 15th instalment of the PM Kisan Samman Nidhi, a sum of Rs 2,000, has to be released into the accounts of farmers before Diwali. Therefore, all work pertaining to e-KYC of farmers, linking of their bank accounts to their Aadhaar cards and land seeding should be completed by October 31, he said. TNN
