G20 SETS A MILESTONE OF GROWTH

INDIA ASSUMED THE G20 PRESIDENCY FROM INDONESIA AND CONVENED THE G20 LEADERS' SUMMIT FOR THE FIRST TIME IN THE COUNTRY THIS YEAR. IMPORTANT G20 MEETINGS WERE HELD IN UTTAR PRADESH BETWEEN DECEMBER 2022 AND NOVEMBER 2023

For the success of the G20 summit and related events requires coordination between numerous ministries and agencies in order to ensure the success of the summit and related events.

The following are a few of the crucial divisions that helped the Lucknow G20 event succeed like the Ministry of External Affairs served as the primary liaison between the host country and other member countries, ensuring that all logistical and administrative arrangements are in place. They, along with the line ministry, were in charge of overseeing the summit's planning, including lodging, transportation, and security for delegates and visitors.

The Department of Urban Development's main responsibilities included beautification and sprucing up different locations to welcome G20 participants. The Lucknow Development Authority, Airport Development Authority, and Public Works Department, among others, collaborated closely with the Urban Development Department to coordinate efforts and make sure that the city's infrastructure and amenities were up to the mark for the G20 summit.

LUCKNOW

The state of Uttar Pradesh prepared for the G20 summit by renovating four cities, including Lucknow, in advance of G20-related events. The Municipal Commissioners of Lucknow, Agra, Varanasi, and the Chief Executive of the Greater Noida Authority were urged to begin the preparations.

Lucknow hosted the G20 Summit wherein various projects were undertaken to make the city 'smarter'. The five-kilometre heritage corridor — from Kaiserbagh to Hazratganj, was revived to promote the historical monuments of the city. All such monuments located on this 5km heritage zone were revamped and decorated to welcome delegates for the G20 and G15 events.

In addition to these efforts, various other initiatives were given a fresh coat of paint, the overall area was further enhanced, and the walls beneath flyovers and boundary walls received beautification. Additionally, the administration conducted road renovations.

Facade illumination was also installed. The eight heritage monuments covered under the project included Badli Imambara, and within it, Naudhat Khana, Chitra Imambara, Clock Tower, Rumi Darwaza, Shah Ali Khan's Tomb, Khati Darwaza, Vilas and Khati Gahwan-e-Khan.

VARANASI

Varanasi hosted the G20 Development Ministers' Meeting from June 11 to 13. The development ministers of G20 member countries gathered in Varanasi, for three days. The summit focused on issues such as disruptions in global supply chains, problems with food and energy security, and the effects of climate change, among others.

The G20 development ministerial meeting was an opportunity to collectively agree on actions for accelerating achievement of the SDGs and foster synergies between development, environment and climate agendas, while avoiding costly trade-offs that held back progress for the developing countries. Two main sessions — one on 'Multilateralism: Collective actions for accelerating progress towards SDGs' and the other on 'Green development: A LIFE (Life-style for environment) approach', made up the summit.

GREATER NOIDA

The entrance was visible in dark grey rather than its previous light grey and blue colours. Some silver detailing work was also done, with beautiful flower decorations. The statue of Lord Buddha was decorated with attractive lights. The makeover was a part of citywide efforts to upgrade and beautify infrastructure in preparation for the G20 Summit.

The local traffic police personnel also underwent soft skill training to ensure the international visitors do not face any obstacles on the road. The traffic police coordinated with their Delhi counterparts to chalk out plan for glitch-free movement on the roads during the event.

Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath, while addressing the meeting of Digital Economy Working Group (DEWG) highlighted that Uttar Pradesh has used technology to provide a digital platform to investors and is attracting large investments.

Integrating the first meeting of G20 DEWG in Lucknow, CM Yogi Adityanath said, 'Uttar Pradesh is now emerging as a new economy in the world. This can work as a guiding force in the world.'

Uttar Pradesh has streamlined its Public Distribution System (PDS) by digitising it to provide subsidised foodgrains to 15 crore people, which has helped the state save Rs 1,200 crore annually, according to the Chief Minister at the inaugural session of DEWG organised by the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY) in the state capital in February.

As a precursor to the first DEWG meeting in

Lucknow, MeitY held several bilateral sessions and launched several initiatives:

- 'Stay Safe Online' campaign: Raised awareness among citizens of all ages about cyber risks and how to protect oneself online.
- The G20 Digital Innovation Alliance (G20-DIA): The meeting was to support and recognise innovative digital technologies.

A range of workshops, discussions, and experiences, including side events on themes that complement the overall DEWG agenda, were held.

Alongside workshops, Digital Initiatives of the state were also showcased at the venue. Further, an exhibition along with virtual reality experience centre was set up to showcase 'How Digital India has transformed the lives of billion plus population in India using cutting-edge technologies'. Visitors had the opportunity to engage with more than 40 digital transformational initiatives.
