

At groundbreaking, UP plans to make MoUs worth ₹15Lcr a reality

Lucknow: After attracting an investment intent of Rs 39.52 lakh crore at UP Global Investors Summit, UP is now set to translate more than 40% of these projects into a reality at the upcoming groundbreaking ceremony.

In an official review for the event, expected to be held soon, CM Yogi Adityanath was apprised that MoUs worth Rs 15 lakh crore would become a reality at the event.

Presiding over a meeting of additional chief secretaries, principal secretaries of various departments and CEOs of Industrial Development Authorities, the Chief Minister reviewed the department-wise and district-wise investment proposals and gave guidelines for implementation. An official spokesperson said that in the past eight months, more than 8,000 projects got into the implementation stage.

“We should organize a groundbreaking ceremony with industrial projects valued at a minimum of Rs 15 lakh crore. With this goal in mind, all departments should speed up preparations,” the CM told officials.

Yogi said: “Everyone concerned must immediately review every industrial investment proposal received by their respective departments.”
