

Two Fortune 500 companies to set up data centres in UP

Lucknow: Two fortune 500 companies namely Sify Infinit Spaces Limited and Jackson Limited would build data centres in Yamuna Expressway Industrial Development Authority (YEIDA) area, an official spokesperson informed on Tuesday.

"Both the companies have been allotted plots with an area spanning

20,000 sqm for the data centre park in Sector

28 near upcoming Noida International Airport. An investment of Rs 1757.45 crore and employment generation for 775 people is proposed on the allotted plots," the spokesperson said.

YEIDA recently initiated the planning of industrial plots de-

signated for data centres, with the application deadline set for October 26, 2023. Under this scheme, there were five vacant plots available, comprising one plot measuring 1,25,660 square meters (D-1), another plot measuring 40,000 square meters (D-8), and three plots measuring 20,000 square meters each (D-4, D-9, D-10). A total of three applications were received for these five plots.

On Monday, a meeting of the allotment

committee was convened in the hall, during which the committee thoroughly reviewed all three applications and allocated the plots based on the merits of the projects presented. Notably, the entire interview and project presentation process was videographed and photographed.
