Udyami mitras push projects worth ₹50k-cr in four months

Lucknow: Udyami mitras have facilitated projects worth Rs 50,000 crore for Uttar Pradesh in a short span of four months, thereby making a significant contribution to the state government's bid to convert investment intent received during the UP Global Investor Summit 2023 into reality.

This came to the fore at a recent review of Mukhya Mantri Udyami Mitra Scheme chaired by industrial development minister Nand Gopal Gupta Nandi. "Projects worth over Rs 50,000 crore have been facilitated by Udyami

Mitras in the past four months. In addition to this, they are acting as enablers for 1,146 projects worth Rs 74,900 crore. They also helped in on ground verification of 4,591 projects," an official said.

At the maiden briefing of Udyami Mitras in June, chief minister Yogi Adityanath had called them as the 'bridge between government and investors.'

Sources added that Udyami Mitras have helped in solving some key issues which were not finding their way over the past eight months. Most of it related to delays in issuance of lease deeds and NOCs from the development authorities. "In the Shagun

Mart LLP project worth Rs 100 crore under Greater Noida Authority, Udyami Mitras assisted in resolving the issue of pendency in lease deed, no-dues certificates, and check list. In Basti, they helped NCML Private Limited resolve NOCs from the state forest department. In GB Nagar, they helped Open Advance technologies private limited resolve the matter related to time extension for construction," said an official.

A look at the district wise performance indicated that at least 10 Udyami Mitras were able to achieve 100% of the target assigned to them while the average performance has been over 70%.
