

As part of GIS pledge, Mumbai firm hires 19 AKTU freshers

Lucknow: As part of its pledge made during the Global Investors Summit early this year to invest Rs 33 crore in Uttar Pradesh, Mumbai-based multinational IT firm Adrosonic recruited 19 freshers from various colleges affiliated to Dr APJ Abdul Kalam Technical University (AKTU), Lucknow, during its campus drive on Monday.

A recruiting team from the company, led by its CEO & MD, Mayank and COO, Sonal, arrived at the campus to hire talented candidates for their Lucknow centre. About 300 students from BTech, CS and IT streams applied for the selection process, out of which 19 students were shortlisted after multiple rounds of screening and interviews. The selected candidates would be joining Adrosonic in July 2024, once they receive their engineer-
