Commercial operations at Ayodhya airport to start from January 6

New Delhi: IndiGo will be the first airline to operate flights at the soon-to-open Maryada Purushottam Shri Ram International airport in Ayodhya. The inaugural flight from Delhi will arrive in Ayodhya on December 30, 2023. Subsequently, commercial operations for a direct flight will commence between Delhi and Ayodhya from January 6, 2024, followed by tri-weekly flights between Ahmedabad and Ayodhya from January 11, 2024," IndiGo said.
