Yogi wants Jewar to be linked with IGI; asks officials to seek Centre's help

At a meeting to discuss connectivity to the upcoming Jewar Airport on Tuesday, chief minister Yogi Adityanath said that the airport should have a link with the Indira Gandhi International Airport in Delhi and directed officials to prepare a proposal for it with the necessary 'guidance and advice' from the Centre. He said that the state government would provide all necessary resources for it. **P 6**

"There are possibilities that the Prime Minister may inaugurate the airport on December 30. We are doing the preparations but are yet to get the PM's protocol," Gaurav Dayal, commissioner of Ayodhya, told **TOI**.

It is also likely that the

PM may flag off an Vande Bharat Express from Ayodhya railway station, he said.

The inaugural flight from Delhi to Ayodhya is scheduled on December 30.

The Ayodhya Airport is located adjacent to NH-27 and NH-330 at Naka area of Faizabad in Ayodhya.
