

Udyam Saarthi portal & app to promote enterprisers

Lucknow: Additional chief secretary (MSME) Navneet Sehgal has given directions to set up an Udyam Saarthi portal and app to promote entrepreneurship in the state. In a meeting of the Institute of Entrepreneurship Development on Tuesday, the ACS said that through the app, about 1,000 courses on employment, self-employment, planning and skill development will be made available free of cost. People will also be able to learn about details on establishment of industry and related government schemes through the app.

Sehgal said that skill and entrepreneurship universities should offer certificate to degree courses on employment and self-employment.

It was also decided during the meeting to start degree and diploma courses of DPharma and BPharma.

A material testing lab will also be established to train youth in the field of construction.

A board of vocations will also be constituted. Sehgal also gave the green signal for setting up an office of the institute in NCR.
