

Mahana: YEIDA to offer scheme on plots sale on 125 ha

Lucknow: Minister for industrial development Satish Mahana said on Wednesday the Yamuna Expressway Industrial Development Authority will soon launch a scheme, offering 600 plots on 125 hectare land. The minister issued directions to officials for making a policy for home buyers to address complaints of incomplete group housing schemes.

During review of Noida, Greater Noida and Yamuna Expressway Industrial Development Authorities on Wednesday, Mahana said, applications received on Nivesh Mitra portal should be disposed of within the set timeframe. All work pending for quick allocation of land should be completed at the earliest, he said, and warned that action will be taken against the official concerned if complaints are received.

The proposed electronic city and aviation hub development should be given priority and flatted factories should be encouraged in the proposed toy city, the minister said.

Mahana discussed various issues like flat buyers' problems, single window clearance system, Metro projects, investment schemes, land bank, industrial sectors, development of infrastructure facilities, situation of income and expenditure, GIS system, land acquisition and resolution of problems being faced by farmers under each authority.

"All facilities being provided by the authorities should be online and uploaded on the Nivesh Mitra portal. No offline applications should be accepted," the minister said, directing all authorities to ask their departments to make a list of vacant land and submit it to the government at the earliest.
