

Metro to chug out in Kanpur, Agra from Nov

While presenting the state budget, UP finance minister Survesh Khanna informed the House that Kanpur

and Agra Metro will start plying from November 30 this year.

The government has allocated Rs 587 crore for Kanpur Metro and Rs 478 crore for Agra Metro in the budget. "The trial run

on the priority stretches of Kanpur and Agra Metros will begin by July end and the train services will open for public by November this year," Khanna said in his budget speech.

The government has also allocated Rs 100 crore for Varanasi and Gorakhpur Metro projects. The minister also announced of Rs 1,326 crore for Meerut-Ghaziabad Delhi MRTS corridor.
