Lucknow: Chief secretary Rajendra Kumar Tiwari on Tuesday asked officials to ensure construction of all the expressways as per the timeline already fixed for each of them separately.

Holding the project monitoring group's meeting here, he praised the UP Expressways Industrial Development Authority (UPEIDA) for making significant progress with regard to construction of the Bundelkhand Expressway. It was found during the review that the UPEIDA achieved 46% against the 35% target for the Milestone-2.

The CS, however, asked concerning officials to expedite land acquisition for the proposed Ganga Expressway. He stressed the need for being in constant touch with the investors who signed MoUs for investment in the Defence Corridor.

Meanwhile, a committee headed by the chief secretary on Tuesday provided more time to the M/s Mittal Enterprises, Agra to set up a bio CNG plant with 5.1 tone capacity per day in Hapur district.

The industry department issued the letter of comfort to the company in October 2018 for setting up the plant. The company, however, sought extension of the letter of comfort deadline citing difficulties arising due to the pandemic.
