

UP got ₹66k-cr investment proposals during pandemic

Lucknow: Uttar Pradesh has received 96 proposals for investment of Rs 66,000 crore since the outbreak of the Covid-19 pandemic. Land has been allocated to 18 investors who have proposals of Rs 16,000 crore.

The information was shared at a review meeting of industrial development chaired by chief minister Yogi Adityanath where he directed officials to ensure that all such investment proposals received during the past year

are implemented on priority.

“The CM said that these projects should be implemented at the earliest. UP receiving this kind of response du-

ring a pandemic is an indication of investors having faith in UP’s policies, the CM said,” stated a government spokesperson.

Yogi has asked the departments concerned to remain in constant touch with investors and extend all possible

help, subsidies to them as per the policy pertaining to their sector of investment.

The CM also discussed the UP Oxygen Production Promotion Policy, 2021, to make the state self-sufficient in oxygen production for medical and industrial use. “Many companies have expressed interest in setting up oxygen production plants in the state and the CM has asked officials to remain in touch with the top management of these companies to provide them with all possible help,” the spokesperson said.
